Computer Classes

The computer classes, which started in 2011, in the annex building (Santi Ashram) continue to provide basic computing skills. We are now however only 10 in attendance. Our earlier teacher has rejoined. The PC' and other equipment are aging and so it has been decided to replace them one at a time in 6 monthly intervals.

There is now direct internet connection and these youngsters from Hirna gram can join the **www.**

It is expected that the employability of these students will increase significantly.
